October 26, 2011 Minutes

MEETING MINUTES: Minutes of the September 20, 2011 meeting were approved by e-mail and forwarded to the township trustees and representatives of the Licking Land Trust.

PUBLIC RELATIONS: no issues presented

PARKS AND TRAILS: Grace reported that the Ailes family had installed a plaque for the Red Bud memorial tree planted last year. Judy asked about the memorial tree plaques that had been along side the bathhouse before it was demolished. Grace didn't know but will check into the matter.

Judy said Greg had told her there were no more SVP trail maps available. She will see about getting more.

The stream restoration project has been completed and landscaping work has begun. The old bathhouse area has been cleared, leveled and seeded. Grace questioned the presence of a large block of concrete still in the former dam area of the stream. Since there was an understanding that all concrete pieces would be removed from that area, she was asked to check on it.

Judy presented Andrew Monnin's plan for the handicapped port-o-john walling at Spring Valley to the township trustees. The plan was approved and Andrew will proceed with the project after finding more funding. The approved plan is for a fencing style enclosure and calls for the port-o-john to stay in the area between the parking lot and platform tennis site.

AGRICULTURE: no issues presented

DEVELOPMENT RIGHTS: Judy reported that no further action has taken place regarding the possible split / sale of the Smith property on which the township holds a conservation easement.

After reviewing the materials relevant to the inspection and monitoring of township properties that hold a conservation easement, it was decided to add the actual address of each property to the form. Grace asked that we send her an electronic copy of the completed report forms for her review.

Judy will contact Mrs. Adrian Smith to see if the committee may walk her property on Sunday, December 4, 2011 at 1:30 p.m.

OTHER: The trustees have asked for suggestions for naming the roadway on the left at the entrance to Spring Valley. After hearing several suggestions from the members, the committee decided to offer "Salt Run Drive" as our recommendation.

The terms of membership for Roger Dunifon and Mickey Smith expires in December, 2011. Mickey said she would like to continue her work with the committee. Roger will make a decision later.
