Minutes of Regular Meeting, October 14, 2015

Trustee Schott called the regular meeting of the Township Trustees to order at 7:00 PM followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of Meeting Minutes

Trustee Bennett made a motion to approve the minutes of the September 23, 2015, meeting. Trustee Abraham seconded the motion and the motion passed by unanimous vote.

Public Comment

There was no public comment at this meeting.

Correspondence Received or Sent

FO Miller reported he:

- Received a notice from the Licking County Commissioners reporting the Creno's Restaurant has withdrawn its annexation to the Village due to a technicality in filing procedures. Creno's intent is to re-file at a later date.
- Received a call from a driver on Cambria Mill who reported she got paint on her car from the striping of the roads. FO Miller sent an email to Superintendent Travis Binckley and Trustee Abraham requesting they contact the lady regarding the issue.
- Received a note from the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT), explaining one of its resources is a resident's guide to creating safer communities for walking and biking. FO Miller ordered the guide from ODOT and also sent the email from ODOT to Village Manager, Steve Stilwell.
- Received a note from Pat Deering, of Licking County Soil and Water, asking if Granville Township wanted to become a local sponsor for the Ohio Department of Agriculture's local agricultural easement purchase program, or be included in the program that covers all of Licking County. FO Miller reported last year the Trustees decided not to become a local sponsor and recommended the Trustees not become a local sponsor this year. After discussion, the Trustees decided not to become a local sponsor for the program, but to meet with Ms. Deering occasionally to learn of opportunities at the state level.

Elected Official ReportsFO Miller:

- Received a bill from Bruce Miles, owner of a small local computer repair company, who neglected to send a bill for work he did in 2013 and 2014. Mr. Miles asked to be paid \$450 for the work. FO Miller did research and discovered the bill had not been submitted in 2013 or 2014 and, therefore, had not been paid. FO Miller asked for a motion to pay the bill.

Trustee Abraham made a motion to pay Bruce Miles the \$450 owed to him, Trustee Bennett seconded the motion and the motion passed by unanimous vote.

- Met with Meeder Investment Services, the company which helped the Treasurer of the State of Ohio set up its Star Ohio Plus program and also works with the Licking County Treasures office. FO Miller stated as a Fiscal Officer, one of his responsibilities is investing. To be eligible to invest a Fiscal Officer must be CPIM (Certified Public Investment Manager) Certified. FO Miller noted he had taken the needed classes to be certified and stated he would discuss investment strategies with the newly elected Township Trustee Board.
- There were no appropriation transfers.
- FO Miller provided a list of the warrants and payroll checks issued. FO Miller requested approval for the warrants, withholding vouchers, debit memos, and EFT's which were issued.

Trustee Schott

- On September 25, 2015, attended the monthly Joint Communications Meeting, on behalf of the Trustees.
- Attended a meeting set by Village Manager, Steve Stilwell that included representatives from the Granville Area Chamber of Commerce, Granville Schools and the GRD, regarding potential annexation of Weaver Road properties into the Village.
- Heard from Chad Brown, of the Licking County Health Department, that he will enter the Benson property with the owners on October 22, 2015, and will report back to the Trustees after viewing the property. Mr. Brown also requested that a Trustee attend a meeting on October 26, 2015, regarding the sewage issue on Knoll Drive and Sunset. Trustee Bennett stated he would attend the meeting.

Trustee Abraham

- Reached out to Leonard Hubert regarding his continuation as the Township representative to the Licking County Tax Incentive Council. FO Miller stated Mr. Hubert has agreed.
- Had a meeting to discuss current issues with Village Manager, Steve Stilwell and met the new wastewater treatment manager during the meeting.

Trustee Bennett

- Trustee Bennett spoke to two residents who asked if the broken fence between their properties could be rebuilt, to which Trustee Bennett told them they could.
- Regarding the State Route 161 economic development study, received a call from Jerry Newton, wanting to get an understanding of where the Township was on economic development along State Route 161.

- Spoke to Chief Hussey, in general terms, regarding the feasibility study of the Fire Department by Moody Nolan. Trustee Bennett recommended the Trustees will need to defer discussion regarding the Fire Department until January, after the election of new Trustees.
- Trustee Bennett stated Chief Hussey provided a notice the EMS dispatching service would start charging the Township in 2016. This will be added to the next meeting agenda.

Granville Township Road District

Trustee Abraham reported on behalf of Superintendent Binckley the roads crew:

- Completed the last round of mowing
- Patched culverts on Hankinson Road, Denison Court, Canyon Road and Pembroke Lane

Trustee Abraham on behalf of Superintendent Binckley requested a Purchase Agreement to replace the dump body and salt spreader on the 1999 truck with a new stainless steel one from Ace truck in Zanesville, totaling \$22,500.

Trustee Schott made a motion to purchase the dump body and salt spreader on the 1999 truck with a new stainless steel one from Ace truck in Zanesville for \$22,500 of budgeted monies, Trustee Bennett seconded the motion and without further discussion the motion passed by unanimous vote.

Cemetery Department

Trustee Abraham reported on behalf of Superintendent Binckley:

- Three graves were sold with three deeds needing to be signed.
- Two funerals were held.
- Foundations will be poured later this week.

Trustee Schott noted Trustee Bennett has agreed to attend the Joint Union Cemetery meeting scheduled for 8 AM on October 19, 2015.

Parks/Granville Recreation District(GRD)/Bryn Du Commission

Trustee Schott reported the lease agreement between the Township and the GRD has been officially signed and notarized and FO Miller has the original. Trustee Schott mentioned Andy Wildman, GRD Director reported Mr. Jackson's attorney indicated he had forwarded the information regarding the lot split to Austin Lecklider. Also Mr. Wildman hopes to have the trees planted on the lot line by the end of the year.

Fire Department

In Chief Hussey's absence, there was no report.

Land Management/Open Space

Breymaier Property

Trustee Schott reported she spoke to Steve Layman who had met with Mr. Breymaier and determined the two carve-outs. Mr. Layman has provided easement language (Trustee Schott forwarded to the other Trustees) to forward to an attorney to have formalized. Mr. Layman

would like for the Trustees to move forward to send it to attorney Jim Havens. Trustee Bennett commented that in the future we should also use solo local Granville attorneys.

Trustee Schott made a motion to have a formal easement document reviewed, up to \$2000 from the open space fund, by Attorney Jim Havens, which would be sent back to the Trustees for their review. FO Miller stated he spoke to Mr. Layman who mentioned Mr. Breymaier wanted to put a fruit (produce) stand on the property and suggested Trustee Schott get clarity from Mr. Layman before sending to the attorney. Trustee Schott will get clarification on the fruit stand from Mr. Layman. Trustee Bennett seconded the motion and without further discussion the motion passed by unanimous vote.

Open Space

Trustee Bennett reported he spoke to Doug Wagner regarding streamlining the communication process between the Trustees, Steve Layman and the Open Space Committee.

Zoning Inspector and Compliance Officer

Trustee Abraham reporting on behalf of Zoning Inspector Binckley the following activity:

Zoning Commission

Trustee Schott also received a call from Zoning Commission chair, Rob Schaadt, who reported the Zoning Commission was still working on solar energy language.

Spring Valley Rental Property

Trustee Abraham reported the only item left to be completed was the replacement of the broken window. The contractor is coordinating the replacement with the renters.

Shooting Range – Environmental Study

Trustee Bennett should have, within the week, a report with remedial recommendations from CTL regarding the environmental study at McPeck Lodge. Trustee Bennett indicated the report will identify some areas where the level of lead is above recommended residential levels.

Partitioned Fence Hearing

Trustee Bennett spoke to Mr. Findlayson and Ms. Worth regarding the partition fence between their properties. Trustee Bennett reported the parties had reached an agreement and he sent a letter to the parties involved reflecting the agreement.

Board and Committee Assignments

Zoning Commission

Trustee Schott reported Judy Preston is will continue on the Zoning Commission, as well as the alternates, Tara Parsley and Keith Lonzo.

Zoning Appeals Board

Trustee Schott stated Jim Larimer did not want to continue on the BZA Board. Trustee Schott reached out to alternates Bill Brady and Andy Crawford. Mr. Brady confirmed he is interested in continuing as an alternate. Trustee Schott is still waiting to hear back from Mr. Crawford. Discussion followed on vacancy. Trustee Schott asked if the Trustees were in agreement to ask the alternates first if they wanted to move to a permanent commission position before publicizing the opening. The Trustees agreed. Trustee Bennett commented Mr. Crawford would be a good candidate. Trustee Schott will followup with Mr. Crawford.

Land Management Committee

Trustee Schott reported Greg Dixon, Lynn Connelly and Craig Connelly would like to be reappointed.

Arts Council

Trustee Bennett stated he would contact Mickey Smith to determine if she wanted to continue.

Open Space

Trustee Bennett reported Bill Wernet is interested in continuing on the Open Space Committee, but wishes to discuss, as a courtesy, with Chairperson Doug Wagner.

Licking County Tax Incentive Council

Leonard Hubert is willing to continue as the Townships representative.

Volunteer Dependency Board

Trustee Schott reported Chief Hussey will see if the current board members wish to continue.

The Trustees agreed the final approval of all board appointments will be made at a later meeting.

New Business

There was no new business at this time.
