Minutes of Regular Meeting, April 13, 2016

Trustee Schott called the meeting to order at 7 PM followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Agenda Approval

Trustee Bennett made a motion to approve the agenda for the April 13, 2016, meeting. Trustee VanNess seconded the motion and the motion passed by unanimous vote.

Approval of Meeting Minutes

Trustee Bennett made a friendly amendment in spelling to the March 9, 2016, meeting minutes of “lean” to “lien”. Trustee Schott asked Trustee Bennett if this was a motion and seconded the motion. No one opposed the motion, so Trustee Schott stated she took that as everyone was in favor of the motion.

Trustee VanNess made a motion to add to the minutes of March 9, 2016, that the \$2800 to pay Jim Murr for appraisal services will be paid from the General Fund. Trustee Schott seconded the motion and the motion passed by unanimous vote.

Trustee VanNess made a motion to approve the minutes of the March 30, 2016, multi-jurisdictional meeting at Bryn Du mansion. Trustee Bennett seconded the motion and the motion passed by unanimous vote.

Public Comment

Dr. Timothy Miller made a presentation to amend the Green Space easement at 4172 Loudon Street, Granville, Ohio.

Following Dr. Miller’s presentation, the Trustees had a discussion regarding making changes to Green Space easements. Trustee Bennett mentioned the Trustees needed to have a discussion with the Land Management Committee and the Open Space Committee regarding the possibility of creating criteria to make amendments to Green Space easements.

Lynn Connelly mentioned the missing tombstone of George Case was found at Spring Valley. Trustee Bennett proceeded to tell the history of the Granville cemeteries.

Lynn Connelly asked the Trustees, “What is the point of having Green Space if we are not going to stay with them.” Ms. Connelly added, “If we are going to change the Green Space, why did we vote for Green Space?” Once we start changing the easements it will open Pandora’s box. (To which Trustee VanNess agreed.)

Public Comment was closed at 7:42 PM.

Correspondence Received or Sent

Trustee Schott commented Fiscal Officer Miller would like to know if the Trustees would like to waive the post audit. Trustee VanNess made a motion to waive the post audit, Trustee Bennett seconded the motion and the motion passed by unanimous vote.

Trustee Bennett received an e-mail from an official of the Ohio EPA inquiring about the assessment of McPeck Lodge, to which Trustee Bennett replied to the official noting the course of action the Trustees intend to take.

Trustee Schott wanted to make sure all Trustees received an invitation from the Granville Historical Society and a copy of the 2015 annual report from the Licking County Health Department.

Elected Official Reports

Fiscal Officer Miller

FO Miller was absent

Trustee Schott

Trustee Schott reported all her items are later in the agenda.

Trustee Bennett

Trustee Bennett reported the following:

- Attended the Licking County Health Department meeting dealing with the sewer and aerator system inspection
- Attended the Pipeline Disaster Conference in Zanesville
- Attended a meeting with Granville Village and other officials
- Attended a Town and Gown meeting at Denison with Chief Hussey
- April 15, 2016, will meet with the Tree Commission regarding getting a tree at the Union Cemetery.

Trustee VanNess

Trustee VanNess reported the following:

- Travis Binckley and Trustee VanNess met with Granville Village Manager Steve Stilwell and Village Service Director Terry Hopkins with the objective to get in writing the trade offs of maintenance and snow removal between the Village and Township.
- Discussed the annexation requested by Lee Heckman regarding property on the southeast corner of Newark Granville Road and Fairview Avenue. The main reason for Mr. Heckman’s request was his failing septic system and the Licking County Health Department

recommended he hook into the Village's system. Mr. Heckman is asking for an expedited type 2 annexation under 709.023. Trustee VanNess noted he was talking to APA Austin Lecklider regarding the annexation and talked to former Fiscal Officer Norm Kennedy regarding the original annexation, giving Mr. Kennedy permission to speak to APA Lecklider about the annexation.

- Doug Wagner talked to Trustee VanNess regarding a possible TIF on River Road to build a veterinary office. Trustee VanNess asked Trustee Bennett to discuss a tract of land, owned by the Township, which was donated in 2005 by Harold Parker. Trustee Bennett mentioned APA Lecklider should be contacted regarding the land that could possibly be annexed into the Village. Trustee VanNess asked Trustee Bennett to follow up with APA Lecklider.

Granville Township Road District

Superintendent Binckley reported the following:

- Fulfilled the obligation of the salt contact and the salt barn is at full capacity
- Spent two weeks working on James Road with Union Township and the work being done by Union Township is a work in progress
- We will be working on a signed agreement with Union Township
- Four employees attended a safety workshop
- Received an email request from a resident asking to place a streetlight at James Road and Route 37. Superintendent Binckley noted the intersection meets the standards of the highway (in the manual). After discussion, the Trustees decided a streetlight would not be put up.
- Superintendent Binckley requested permission to purchase a Swartzy spray patcher machine for potholes (that is in the budget).

Trustee VanNess made a motion to purchase the Swartzy spray patcher machine for road maintenance for \$25,000. Trustee Schott seconded the motion and the motion passed by unanimous vote.

- Superintendent Binckley noted this year the Township paving projects are 4.2 miles of road, requiring 44 hundred tons of asphalt which has been budgeted. Superintendent Binkley noted APA Lecklider stated there might be a possibility some paving would be on state bid. Superintendent Binckley stated the process is: he needs approval from the Trustees to send the request to the engineer's office in order to get an official estimate for the paving project before Superintendent Binckley is allowed to put it out for bid.

Cemetery Department

Superintendent Binckley reported the following:

- There were three burials
- Two graves were sold
- One deed needs to be signed

Parks/Granville Recreation District(GRD)/Bryn Du Commission

Superintendent Binckley reported some patching had been done.

Trustee Schott started discussion regarding a proposed tree for Don Wiper. Regarding benches, the GRD wants to use the bench policy used by the Village. Trustee Schott asked if the Trustees

believe the Township needs a tree/bench policy since the Township has a lease agreement with the GRD.

Trustees VanNess and Bennett commented they would like to read the Village's policy. Trustee Schott stated she would continue to work with GRD Director, Andy Wildman, as well as Village Councilman Jeremy King. Trustee Schott asked Judy Preston, of the Land Management Committee, to email the Land Management Tree Policy to her.

Fire Department

Fire Chief Hussey reported the following:

- **INCIDENT ACTIVITY:** Although call volume was down early in the year, we have seen a significant increase with 538 calls YTD. We have assisted Newark and Thorn Township Fire Departments with several structure fires in the past month. We responded to a small kitchen fire in a Denison University dormitory on March 29th. In late March, crews assisted Granville Schools and US Fish and Wildlife with a prescribed 50 acre burn on the GIS land lab. We also successfully completed a live fire training on Lancaster Rd. in late March.
- **MEETINGS AND EVENTS:** Crews were invited to Denison University to participate in an emergency response exercise. Crews utilized the NIMS incident management system in conjunction with Denison's crisis response team. The exercise went well and received positive feedback from participants.
- **NEW MEDIC:** Chief Hussey, Captain Curtis and two committee members travelled to Van Wert on Monday to conduct a final inspection on the new ambulance. A few minor items were noted and quickly corrected. The truck is ready for delivery in two weeks, once it has returned from FDIC in Indianapolis.
- **FIRE GEAR PURCHASE:** As part of planned capital purchases, a purchase request was presented to the Board for five sets of structural turnout gear. The total cost is \$12,325 for five coats, pants and boots from Finley Fire Equipment. The replacement of five sets per year maintains an adequate inventory based on the NFPA recommended ten-year life span. It also allows the FD to replace the most worn equipment each year, and provides an opportunity to fit new members as needed.

Trustee VanNess made a motion to purchase five sets of turnout gear at a budgeted cost of \$12,325, Trustee Bennett seconded the motion and the motion passed by unanimous vote.

- **PERSONNEL ISSUES**
- **RESIGNATION:** Chief Hussey presented, with regrets, the resignation of part time firefighter Steve Riley. Mr. Riley has been a ten-year member and is a model employee. Mr. Riley works fulltime for Columbus Fire and is assigned to Station 14 on Parsons Avenue. He brought a great deal of knowledge and an infectious positive attitude to our part-time ranks. He will certainly be missed.
- **VOLUNTEER APPOINTMENT:** Chief Hussey presented Denison student Amanda Walsh for appointment as a new volunteer firefighter/ EMT. Ms. Walsh will be filling an intern position at the FD this summer and attending CTEC for EMT training during her summer break. Ms. Walsh is a freshman from suburban Chicago who is studying pre-medicine.

Trustee VanNess made a motion to accept the resignation of Steve Riley and appoint Amanda Walsh as volunteer firefighter. Trustee Schott seconded the motion and the motion passed by unanimous vote.

- **PARTTIME INTERVIEWS:** Interviews for two or three new part time firefighter paramedics are ongoing as we work to fill a few open positions in the part time and intermittent ranks.
- **FDIC CONFERENCE:** Most of the truck committee members will be travelling to Indianapolis late next week for the Fire Department Instructors Conference (FDIC). There is no admission cost; as we have been able to obtain free passes for the classes and exhibits. A few personnel may stay overnight and are providing their own lodging.
- **ROOF REPAIRS DORM HOUSE:** Chief Hussey has communicated with Trustee Bennett regarding needed roof repairs to the lower, one story portion of the dorm house (135 E. College). This section needs a shingle tear off and re-roofing with similar asphalt shingles. In an effort to minimize cost, fire department personnel will do this work while on duty. Cost of materials will be approximately \$1500.

Land Management/Open Space

Judy Preston, of the Land Management Committee provided the overview of the March 31, 2016 Land Management Committee meeting.

There was no report on Open Space Committee.

Trustee Bennett stated he would plan a meeting to discuss making changes to Open Space Easements.

Zoning

Zoning Inspector and Compliance Officer Travis Binckley reported the following:

- The junk vehicle at the Benson property will be removed when the land dries out.
- Inspector Binckley noted he expected to receive an application/variance to put in a ground mount solar array, which will be forwarded to the Zoning Appeal Board.
- Still working with McKean Township regarding the possibility of a house being built on the Granville Township/McKean Township line.

Zoning Commission

Trustee Schott reported on the Zoning Commission as follows:

Zoning Commissioner Rob Schaadt made application on Solar Array Language with the Licking County Planning Commission to be on the agenda of the LCP Board meeting of March 25, 2016.

Zoning Commissioners Rob Schaadt and Steve Brown will attend the LCPC meeting.

The Zoning Commission will have a Public Hearing on Solar will be May 2, 2016, at 7 PM.

Board of Zoning Appeals (BZA)

The ZBA did not meet in February.

Old Business

Shooting Range –Environmental Study

Trustee Bennett reported the Denison class provided a good product on the McPeek Lodge shooting range. Trustee Bennett recommends hearing what are the recommendations/expectations of the Ohio EPA on the subject before making any remediation at McPeek Lodge. Trustee Bennett recommends working with the GRD to put up warning signs and maybe a fence to block off people coming up from the bike path. Also the water will be tested.

Trustee Bennett made a motion to authorize up to \$200 to test water at McPeek Lodge. Trustee Schott seconded the motion and the motion passed by unanimous vote.

SR 37/James Road Property:

Trustee Schott noted there was no interest in the property at this time and the For Sale sign has been removed.

Burtridge Noise Complaint

Trustee Bennett reported he has not heard anything back regarding the noise complaint. Trustee Schott stated the Burtridge Noise Complaint would be removed from the agenda.

New Business

Spring Clean-Up Program

Superintendent Binckley stated he had no issues/reasons to not continue the program and thought it was a worthwhile service. Superintendent Binckley recommended operating the program the exact same way as it was done last year.

Trustee Schott made a motion to have the Clean-up Program on April 30, 2016, to May 8, 2016. Trustee VanNess seconded the motion and the motion passed by unanimous vote.

Trustee Schott brought up another matter under new business, stating she received an email from the Economic Development Group which would like to have a standing meeting time.

Trustee Bennett made a motion to move into Executive Session pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 121.22 G1 and 121.22 G2. Trustee Schott seconded the motion and called the roll. The roll call was as follows:

The Trustees moved into Executive Session at 8:52 PM.

At 9:30 PM Trustee Bennett moved to end the Executive Session and move back into Regular Session. Trustee VanNess seconded the motion. Trustee Schott called the roll as follows:
