

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING


This MOU is between The Board of Granville Township Trustees and Kendal of Granville.


The Granville Township Board of Trustees will submit a priority two application to the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) for funding in the amount of \$95,550 for a traffic light at the intersection of State route 16 and Kendal Drive.

The traffic light project can only proceed if the Ohio Department of Transportation approves the applied for traffic light permit submitted in Granville Townships name. If maintenance costs are imposed by the Ohio Department of Transportation Kendal of Granville shall be responsible for them.


In the event that that the OPWC project funding is denied The Board of Granville Township Trustees shall fund 50% of the project up to the applied for OPWC funding of \$95,550 subject to The Board of Kendal of Granville agreeing to give the Board of Granville Township Trustees/Licking County a 60' right of way for a connector road from the new traffic light to the Township property in a mutually agreed upon area to be determined within 6 months after the OPWC grant application is submitted. The surveying and construction costs for the connector road shall be paid for by the Township. As part of the process, the parties also agree to consider including a walking/biking pathway alongside or within the connector road right of way with plans to extend the pathway the length of the existing Township drive. The walking/biking pathway shall be funded by Kendal of Granville.

The Board of Granville Township Trustees will take the lead in the project. Kendal of Granville shall reimburse Granville Township expenses exceeding 50% of the project and all expenses over Granville Townships funding cap of \$95,550 within 30 days of submitting paid expenses. Since the project exceeds \$50,000 it will have to be bid out. The Board of Granville Township Trustees should find out by May of 2018 if The Board of Granville Township Trustees are awarded the OPWC funding. If approved, bids can't be officially awarded until July of 2018.
